Catalogue: Archive of the Order of St John – National Malta Library¹

The National Malta Library holds the Archives of the Order of Saint John brought to the Island after the Order's expulsion from Rhodes. The Archives have documents dating to the Crusader Period and extends up to then expulsion of the Order by Napoleon Bonaparte in 1798. Many of the Archives' documents have been systematically catalogued, and these catalogues have been published, though not completely.

The published catalogues have been reviewed to identify entries that may be relevant to the history of the Order of Saint Lazarus [OSL], especially, but not exclusively, relevant to the period when the Order of Saint Lazarus was being managed by members of the Order of Saint John of Jerusalem. During this period, the individuals managing the French branch of the Order of Saint Lazarus centred at Boigny were members of the Order of Saint John [OSJ]. They included four individuals who particularly enjoyed French Royal favour and were appointed to the post by the reigning French monarch with the approval of the Holy See and the Grand Council of the Order of Saint John. In the interim, a second branch of the medieval Order of Saint Lazarus had been allowed to develop by the Holy See. This was the South Italian branch managed independently from Capua. This branch also negotiated dealings with the Order of Saint John during the latter part of the 16th century, which dealing are also archived in the collection.
